COCONUT DEVELOPMENT BOARD

Conditions for the grant of subsidy under integrated farming programme:-

1. The application for subsidy shall be made in the form prescribed by the board and the same shall be submitted through the Department of Agri. / Horti / Krishi Bhawan in duplicate.
2. The applicant should have legal right of possession on the coconut garden (copy of the land tax may be attached).
3. The planting density should not exceed 175 palms/hect after replanting and not more than the officially recommended levels in each state.
4. Subsidy will be disbursed only after the prescribed operations are carried out in accordance with the recommendations.
5. The Subsidy will be granted on the basis of the actual no. of palms cut and removed and replanted. No of palms covered under fertilizers application and P.P. measures are covered under inter mixed cropping. Compensation for cutting and removing will not be allowed for those palms below 7 years. However, the disease affected young palms are also not removed for claiming the compensation.
6. If any person found to have obtained subsidy by fraud or by misrepresentation, the entire amount with 12 % interest shall be recovered.
7. The beneficiaries are bound to provide any information on the coconut holdings for which the subsidy is granted to the board officials as and when required. Farmers who avail subsidy /financial assistance from the Board shall not avail the same from other source for the same purpose.
8. Fertilizers schedule especially for the root (wilt) disease affected areas should include Magnesium also either along with NPK or separately.
9. Organic manures should also be added in addition to the chemicals fertilizers.
10. P.P. Chemicals already banned and environment hazardous materials should not be used for adopting plant protection measures (especially DDT, EHC, Monoarotphosphose etc.) Instead of organic substances like neem cake, neem oil, marroti cake etc. may be promoted.
11. Subsidy for multi spices cropping may be extended to existing intercrops or to new introductions.
12. One copy of the application form after disbursement of subsidy shall be forwarded to the Headquarters of the Board.
